A panel of judges will rate each application on the following criteria:

- How well the Best Practice aligned with the Company's overall mission
- Recognizable and measurable positive outcomes, such as, increased level of customer satisfaction, reduction in turnover, etc.
- Value added through process improvements

Judging

A panel of judges will select the HR Best Practice Award recipient. The panel will consist of the Best Practices Chair, the Communications and Awards Chair, and the Immediate Past State Council Director.

Presentation

The HR Best Practice Award will be presented annually at the Arkansas Human Resource State Conference & Expo.
