Application Criteria

Individuals nominated for this prestigious award will be evaluated on four major areas:

- Honestly, leadership, commitment, competence, integrity and moral strength.
- Vision for moving the field of Human Resources forward.
- Project and/or program success that have benefited the profession and HR professionals.
- Contributions to the profession that truly stand out.

Judging

A panel of judges will select the recipient. The panel will consist of the current SHRM members from within the state of Arkansas as approved by the state council. The application process and recipient selection are overseen by the AR State Council Communication Chair.

Each judge will review and rate the applicant on a scale from 1 to 10 with "1" being the lowest marks for that criterion, and "10" being the highest. The winner of the Jim Wilkins Lifetime Achievement Award will be the applicant with the highest cumulative point total. If nominees do not meet the criteria as outlined or if no nominations are received, no award will be presented. Only one award will be given each year.
